

# 2017 ANNUAL LĀNA‘I RESIDENT HUNT

- WHO:** **U.S. Citizen** – Ten (10) years and older with valid State of Hawaii Hunting License. Ten (10) to Fifteen (15) year-olds must be accompanied by an adult licensed hunter at all times.
- Non-U.S. Citizen:** Twenty-One (21) years and older must have current firearms permit from Police Department. (Exclusions: Hawaii Revised Statutes, Chapter 134-Firearms and Ammunition).
- DEFINITION OF RESIDENT:** A resident is a person who permanently resides on the island of Lāna‘i. It also includes new permanent Company employees (not seasonal), taking up residency on Lāna‘i. It does not include non-resident owners or individuals who are temporarily employed on Lāna‘i by non-resident employers (contractors, etc.). To check residency status, we will use such criteria as post office box, driver’s license address, voter’s registration, tax “home”, etc.
- FIREARMS:** Shotguns – 20 gauge or larger, slugs or 00 buckshot  
Rifles – 1200 ft. lbs muzzle energy or more  
Muzzle loaders – 45 cal. Minimum  
Archery – Bows with Minimum 30 lb. draw weight (See below for Safety Attire)
- BAG LIMIT:** (4) Mammals per Hunter – Maximum of (2) Males only (See Examples Below)  
(1 Buck & 1 Ram & 2 Does or Ewes) or (2 Bucks or Rams & 2 Does) or (2 Bucks or Rams & 2 Ewes) or (1 Buck or Ram & 3 Does or Ewes) or (4 Does or Ewes) or (2 Does & 2 Ewes) or (1 Doe & 3 Ewes) or (3 Does & 1 Ewe)
- Deboning of game is allowed.
- HUNT DAYS:** Saturday, October 07, 2017 – Youth (10 – 15 yrs. of age)  
Saturday, October 14, 2017 – First Letter of Last Name (K - Z)  
Saturday, October 21, 2017 – First Letter of Last Name (A - J)
- PERMITS:** Issued at Lāna‘i Resorts, LLC - Game Management Office weekdays only.  
Youth (10 - 15 yrs. of age) on Mon. – Fri., October 02 - 06, 2017 – 2 pm – 5 pm  
Last names beginning with (K - Z) on Mon. – Fri., October 09 - 13, 2017 – 2 pm – 5 pm  
Last names beginning with (A - J) on Mon. – Fri., October 16 - 20, 2017 - 2 pm – 5 pm
- HUNT HOURS:** One-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset.
- HUNT AREA:** All of Unit A and B area bordered by East Hauola, Munro Trail, ridge east of Manele Road and Keomoku Road and all of Unit C. No hunting within 500 feet from Keomoku Road and Munro Trail.
- FEES:** No fees.
- CHECK IN:** Hunters must sign in and out. Sign-out sheets will be posted outside the Game Management Office (Back of Central Admin. Bldg.) at 4 p.m. on the Friday prior to hunt dates.
- HUNTER'S ASSISTANT (BAG BOY):** Only Youth & Disabled licensed hunters will be allowed to have a licensed parent, legal guardian, or hunter's assistant (bag boy) for their assigned hunting day. No spectators allowed.
- SAFETY VEST:** Bright orange vest or garment must be worn at all times in hunting area, Archery included (no faded t-shirts).
- GUN CASES:** Police will be checking for firearms registrations and proper gun cases on public highways.  
Please read the HRS - Hawaii Revised Statutes / CCM - County Code of Maui / HAR - Hawaii Administrative Rules.
- CARCASSES:** Please dispose of carcasses properly. We have received many complaints about carcasses around the city. Hunters do not need this kind of publicity!
- VIOLATIONS:** Will result in loss of hunting privileges.
- CAUTION:** BE CAREFUL!! Stay out of Kuleana lands & watch for other hunters, beachgoers, bikers, hikers, fishermen, tourists and campers along Keomoku Beach Road, Munro Trail and Awehi Road. Do not fire towards the beach!! PLEASE DISPOSE OF CIGARETTES PROPERLY!!
