

Aloha,

Thank you for inquiring about camping at Hulopo'e Beach Park on Lāna'i, which is privately operated. To better manage the popularity of overnight camping and beach park use by non-Lāna'i residents, all inquiries to this e-mail address will be responded to within 72 hours.

To make an **Overnight Camping Request**, please provide all required information, and within 72 hours, your request will either be confirmed or further information will be requested from you.

Permit and camping fees are as follows:

- Permit Fee: \$50 which covers up to 4 overnight campers for a maximum of 3 nights. (camping permits are issued upon arrival only).
- Camping Fee: \$15 per person, per night, regardless of age.

Only credit card payments are accepted. No discounts are available.

Before submitting your **Overnight Camping Request** information below, please be aware of the following black-out dates. Camping permits for non-Lāna'i residents will not be issued for these holiday periods.

Please include the following required information in your Overnight Camping Request:

- 1) Contact person name, phone number, and e-mail address
- 2) Dates requested (3 night maximum)
- 3) Names of all campers in your group
- 4) Travel itinerary (i.e., dates and times of arrival and departure, and whether traveling by plane or ferry)
- 5) Camping requests should be sent to info@lanaibeachpark.com.

Notes

- Sites are assigned in advance. Check-in time is from 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 p.m.
- Air mattresses or sleeping pads are recommended as the camp grounds are firm. Camping areas are designated and not permitted on the sandy beach.

NOT Allowed

- Pets
- Bon-fires
- Illegal substances
- Weapons, guns archery bows, etc.
- Spear-guns or 3 prongs
- Spearfishing or harvesting of any marine mammals
- Kayaks
- Loud music or noise
- Skateboarding

Any violation of the park rules and regulations may result in termination of the camping permit.
