

Hulopoʻe Beach Park ~ Non-Lānaʻi Resident Camping

Hulopoʻe Beach Park, which is privately operated is a popular location for both overnight camping and day beach use. To better manage the requests received, we ask that all non-Lānaʻi resident inquiries be directed to: info@lanaibeachpark.com. We will respond to your request within 72 hours.

Please include the following required information in your Overnight Camping Request:

- 1) Contact person name, phone number, and e-mail address
- 2) Dates requested (3 nights maximum)
- 3) Names of all campers in your group
- 4) Travel itinerary (i.e., dates, and times of arrival and departure, and whether traveling by plane or ferry)
- 5) Camping requests should be sent to info@lanaibeachpark.com

Camping fees are as follows:

\$80 per night up to 4 people (regardless of age) for a maximum of 3 nights.

Only credit card payments are accepted upon check in at the campsite. No discounts are available.

Before submitting your **Overnight Camping Request** information, please be aware of the following black-out dates. Camping permits for non-Lānaʻi residents will **not** be issued for these holiday periods.

Notes

- Sites are assigned in advance. Check-in time is from 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 p.m.
- Air mattresses or sleeping pads are recommended as the campgrounds are firm. Camping areas are designated and not permitted on the sandy beach.

NOT Allowed

- Pets
- Bon-fires
- Illegal substances
- Weapons, guns archery bows, etc.
- Spear-guns or 3 prongs
- Spearfishing or harvesting of any marine mammals
- Kayaks
- Loud music or noise
- Skateboarding

Any violation of the park rules and regulations may result in termination of the camping permit.
